To sign up for e-Delivery:

1. **Log on to UBS Online Services:** ubs.com/onlineservices.
2. Click on **My Profile** at the top of the home page.
3. Select **Services & Features** and then **e-Delivery**.

You can also contact your UBS Financial Advisor to submit your e-Delivery request. With exception of shareholder communications, online account access is required to retrieve your e-Delivery materials.
