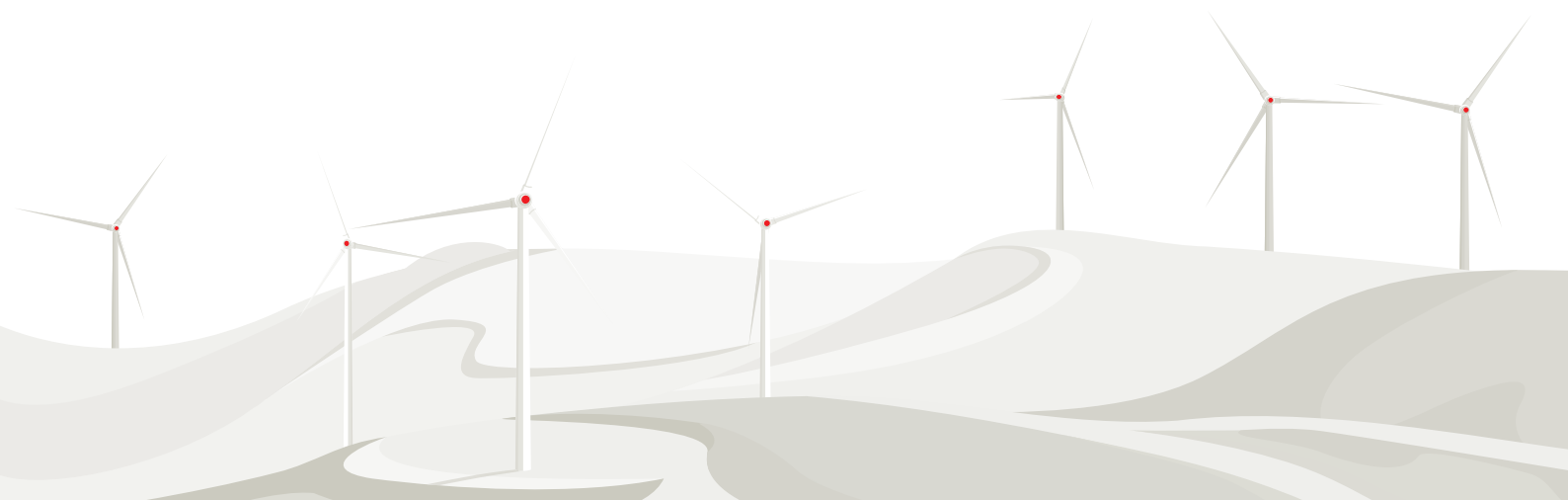
Sir Alok Sharma, a distinguished British politician with an exemplary career in both politics and the business sector, stands out as a fervent advocate for sustainable solutions in the face of climate change. Born in Agra, Uttar Pradesh, India, Sir Alok relocated to Reading with his family at the tender age of five. Following a sound education that culminated in a BSc in Applied Physics with Electronics from the University of Salford, he charted a successful career in corporate finance, advising on cross-border mergers, acquisitions, listings, and restructurings with renowned institutions like Deloitte Haskins & Sells and Skandinaviska Enskilda Banken.

Elected as the Conservative Member of Parliament for Reading West in 2010, Sir Alok quickly became a prominent figure in the political landscape. Notably, his leadership as President for COP26 from 2021 to 2022, where he played a pivotal role in negotiating the Glasgow Climate Pact, speaks volumes about his commitment to addressing climate issues on a global scale.

Sharma's rich political career encompasses a variety of roles. He served in key capacities, from the Minister of State for Housing to the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy. But his consistent thread throughout has been a commitment to blending business acumen with environmentally conscious policies.

His business-friendly approach does not overshadow his dedication to sustainability. In his role as the Secretary of State for International Development, Sharma exhibited this blend by urging the World Bank to direct funds toward fighting climate change and promoting sustainable economies. As the President for COP26, he further demonstrated this commitment by ensuring the United Kingdom's steadfastness to its net zero targets.

In conclusion, Sir Alok Sharma's career is a testament to his unwavering dedication to marrying economic progress with environmental sustainability. He embodies the ideal of a 21st-century leader, capable of navigating the intricate balance between economic growth and the pressing need to safeguard our planet.

He is a Council Member of the Sustainable Energy Association of Singapore (SEAS) and is the Chairman of the Sustainable Energy StartUp Network. Melvyn serves on the Strategic Advisory Board of the Accelerate Blue Fund of the University of Michigan that is dedicated to bringing the research and development of technologies within its faculties across disciplines to commercialization.

Melvyn served as a District Councillor for 6 years in the Environment Functional Committee with the South West Community Development Council. 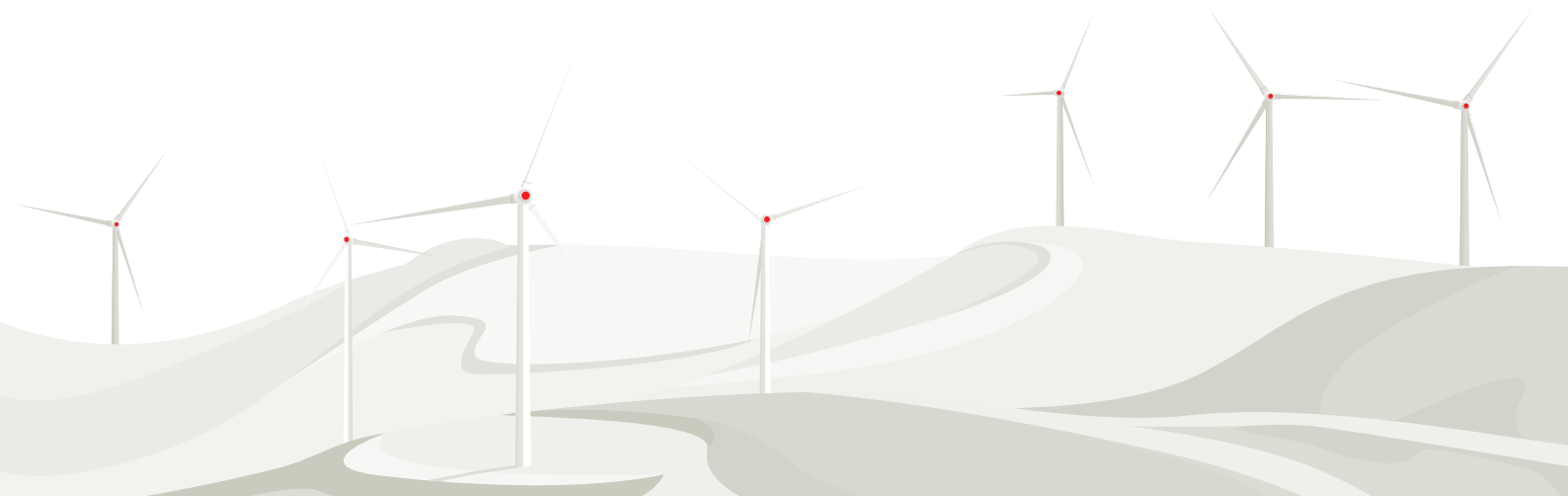

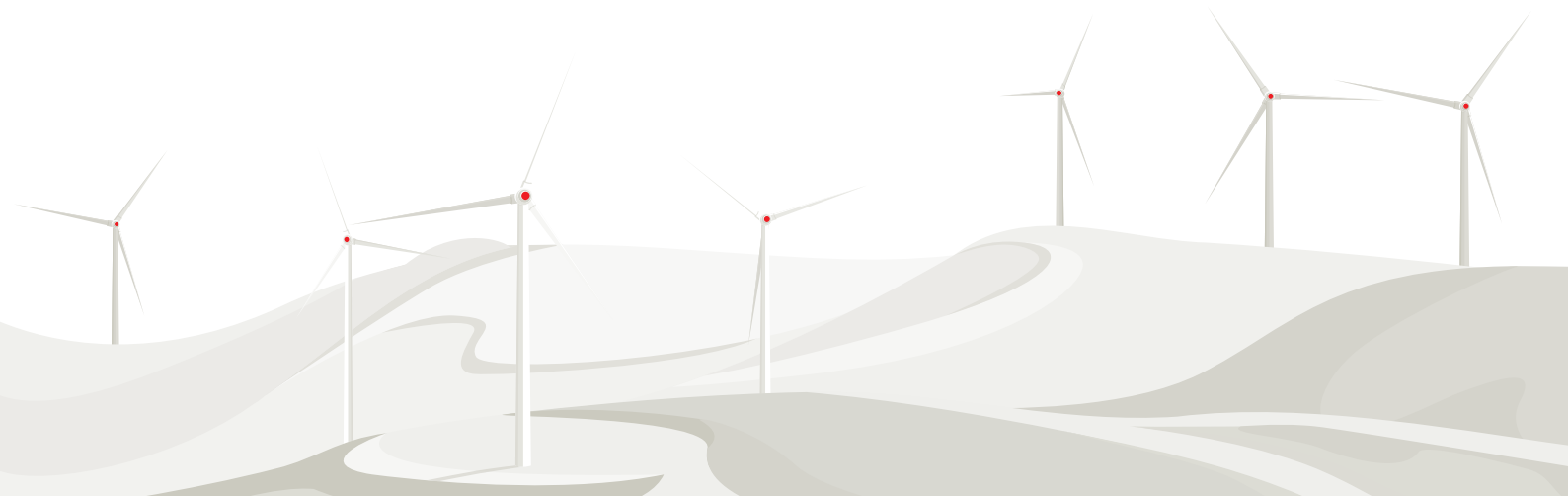

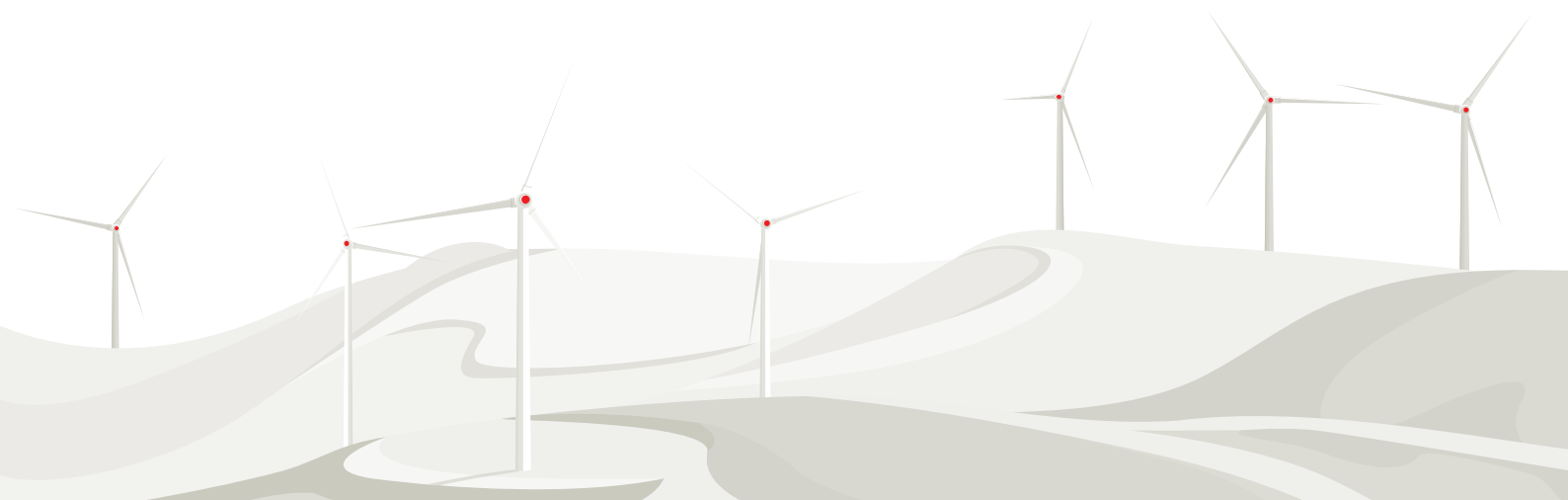
He also represents UBS Group as a Board Member of Swiss Sustainable Finance and is President of the Swiss Banking Association's Expert Commission, Sustainable Finance.
